## UFCW 951 EXPANDS TRANSPORTATION REIMBURSEMENT TO HELP MEMBERS WITH THE RISING COST OF GAS



An extra \$7,500 in transportation reimbursements will be awarded to members in 2022 to help offset the financial impact of the rising cost of gas. Beginning with the second quarter of 2022, UFCW 951 will double the number of members who receive the \$250 reimbursement from 10 to 20 members.

The Transportation Expense Reimbursement Program provides financial relief for fees including gas, car payments, bus fare, taxi/ride-sharing service fees, vehicle registration fees and car repairs.

Transportation Expense Reimbursements are awarded quarterly. Qualifying members' applications are good for the full calendar year, meaning one application provides several chances to win.

## UFCW INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE

In 2022, the UFCW Charity Foundation will award several scholarships up to \$8,000 to be dispersed as \$2,000 scholarships each year at an accredited college or university. The scholarships are limited to UFCW members who have been active since January 1, 2021. The children and dependents of active members are also eligible to apply if they are unmarried and under the age of 20 as of May 31, 2022.
