

Since 2002, the UFCW 951 Foundation has been helping ease the cost of attending college for UFCW 951 members and their families. Fifteen \$2,000 College Scholarships will be awarded in 2024.

Scholarships will be awarded to eligible members, their spouse, children, or their grandchildren (under the age of 25) attending a college, university, community college, or recognized trade school.

To be eligible for a College Scholarship, the student or student's spouse, parent or grandparent must be a UFCW 951 member in good standing for at least three months as of March 1, 2024, and remain a member in good standing throughout the entire academic year.

Scholarship recipients will not be disqualified/ found ineligible due to a medical or military leave of absence.

The UFCW 951 Foundation will notify scholarship winners by March 31, 2024.

Scholarship winners will be selected by a committee composed of representatives from the UFCW 951 Foundation and UFCW 951.

Education scholarships in the amount of \$500 are also available. To apply, you must fill out a separate application available from union representatives or the union website at ufcw951.org/members/scholarships.

General Eligibility

- Applicant must be a member in good standing, or the member's spouse, child or grandchild (grandchildren must be under 25 years of age)
- Full-time or part-time student
- Undergraduate or graduate student
- Accepted to, or attending, an accredited college, university, community college or recognized trade school
- Member must have 90 days in good standing with UFCW 951 as of March 1, 2024, and must remain a member in good standing for the entire academic year
- Previous winners of a UFCW 951 Foundation College Scholarship, UFCW International Scholarship or Union Plus Scholarship of \$1,000 or more are not eligible
- Relatives of UFCW 951 staff or the UFCW 951 Foundation Board of Directors are also ineligible to receive a Foundation Scholarship
- Winning essays and member photos may be quoted and used in future publications.
- **This application is for the \$2,000 College Scholarship only.**
